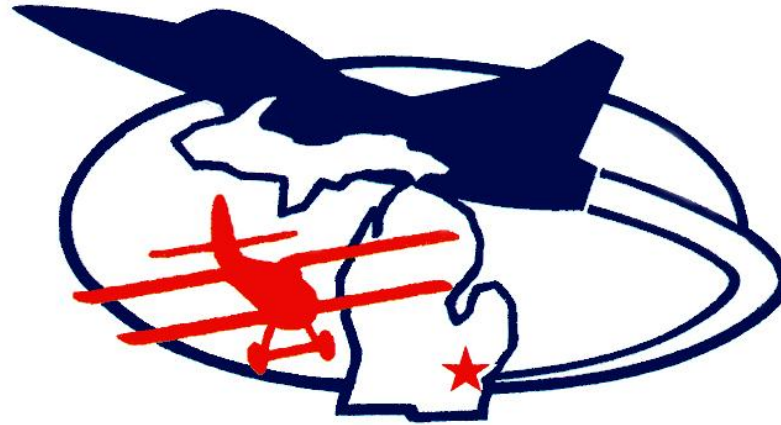


SELFRIDGE MILITARY AIR MUSEUM
